Across the Trust we are very proud of the progress of our pupils. Through a difficult couple of years for pupils in schools nationally due to the disruption caused by the pandemic, our pupils have persevered and on Thursday 24th August 2003 received their GCSE results for the exams they sat earlier this summer.

We have the highest expectations of what our pupils at Wave APAs can achieve, and we are delighted with the number of pupils attaining qualifications in at least 5 GCSE or equivalent awards to support their next steps, as well as their personal progress from their starting points with us.

Often pupils have overcome or work with significant barriers and disruption to their educational journeys. We value every single result.

2023 Headlines (based on Provisional Results)

In the Behaviour APAs (Medical APA to follow once results are all gathered in)

- 73% of students in our Behaviour APA academies achieved a Grade 1-9 GCSE Maths
 (compared to 59% Nationally*)
- 73% of students in our Behaviour APAs achieved a Grade 1-9 in GCSE English (compared to 56% Nationally*)
- 75% of students in our Behaviour APAs achieved a Grade 1-9 in GCSE Science (compared to 36% Nationally*)
- 61% of our students were entered for the equivalent of 5+ GCSE or equivalent Level 2 awards.
- 45% of students in Behaviour APAs gained 1 or more GCSE Grades 9-4
- 41% of students gained 5+ GCSEs including English and Maths,
- 88% of students gained at least 1 GCSE qualification.

These achievements reflect the hard work and commitment of all within our Trust and the wider stakeholder community, and most of all of course, the students



themselves. They compare incredibly favourably to results nationally within the APA sector and we continue to strive for the very best for our young people in terms of preparing them for their next steps in the wider world and post 16 pathways

Highlights from across some of our Academies...

From **Caradon**, "50% of students achieved 8 or more GCSE and/or BTEC qualifications. 75% of students gained a grade 1 - 9 in English Language. Congratulations to SL who achieved 5 GCSE qualifications including a 4 in English Language & English Literature". From **Nine Maidens**, "80% of students gained a grade 1-9 in English Language. 80% of students gained a grade 1-9 in English Literature. 73% of students gained a grade 1-9 in Maths. Congratulations to RY who gained 4 level 2 qualifications and 2 level 1s". From **North Cornwall**, "58% of all students achieved 8 or more GCSE and BTEC qualification. 50% of all students achieved a Level 4 or higher in GCSE Mathematics. Congratulations to ALH who achieved 6 Level 2 qualifications at Grade 4 or higher (including Mathematics and English). Congratulations to AL who achieved a Grade 4 or above in both Mathematics and English".

From **Penwith**, "91% of students achieved a grade 1-9 in English Language. 91% of students achieved a grade 1-9 in Maths. 100% of students achieved a grade 1-9 in Biology. 80% of students achieved 4 or more subjects at grades 1-9".

From **Restormel**, "Congratulations to LSA who achieved 4 GCSE passes and has been accepted on an Apprenticeship. Well done to NW who is about to start a job and has passed 4 GCSEs. All Restormel students have been accepted onto either a college place, employment or apprenticeship- well done!"

From **Stansfield**, "TGR has successful achieved 10 qualifications, 4 x L2, 4 x GCSE and 2 x L1 qualifications, along with a level 2 food hygiene certificate. AC has successful achieved 11 qualifications, 3 x L2, 5 x GCSE and 3 x L1 qualifications, along with a level 2 food hygiene certificate. AC also achieved a Distinction in GCSE Spoken English and in BTEC Construction.
